Born of necessity during the Jim Crow era of strict racial segregation that impacted Americans from cradle to grave, the Hutcherson Funeral Home provided essential services to the community. Learn about the history of one of Lynchburg's oldest funeral homes, the family that started it, and how this essential business has evolved to serve residents today.


Non-Fiction Book Group
