Why is metadata important for oral history?

Metadata is “data about data.” It provides important context for oral history interviews, and helps improve accessibility and discoverability for researchers. Jones Memorial Library (JML) will collect 4 different types of metadata:

- **Descriptive metadata:** the “who, what, and why;” i.e., information about the interview, its participants, and/or the topic(s) discussed.
- **Technical metadata:** information about the audio, video, or other digital files that were created for this interview; including file types, equipment used.
- **Administrative metadata:** information about rights management; including the Oral History Agreement.
- **Structural metadata:** information about how the different parts of the interview relate to the whole.
